ACCOMMODATION

Alexandra Adventure Resort accommodates over 200 people in our Lodges.

Echidna Lodge: Sleeps 62 people and also includes one room that is equipped with a disabled ensuite facility.

Kookaburra Homestead: Sleeps 34 people. With communal showers, toilets and basins all under one roof.

Snake Valley Lodge: Looks out into the mountains in the distance and sleeps 50 people and there is a communal toilet block under the roof line.

Turtle Lakehouse: Sleeps 46 students, and is also equipped with showers, toilets and basins all under one roof, including a disabled ensuite.

Wallaby's Manor: Is our fabulous teachers unit, with comfortable king single beds, a great lounge area with TV, kitchenette with fridge, microwave and coffee machine.

FACILITIES

Dining Room / Multi Purpose Hall: Our dining room seats over I 30 people and is a great space to enjoy our freshly prepared chef cooked meals. With numerous chairs and fold-up tables, this room can be transformed into a multi-purpose use hall. Hot drink facilities along with a fridge, TV and P.A. system are also available in this room for your convenience.

Undercover BBQ Area: Our undercover BBQ area is fantastic for all groups, large and small, and is a great shelter area for those wet days. It can seat up to 180 people for meals.

Large Multi Facility Hall: This huge hall accommodates up to 200 people and can be used for a variety of purposes. It's fully equipped with AV equipment, including a microphone, projector screen, speakers and a whiteboard as well as being sound proof and fully carpeted. Fantastic for those larger groups or rainy days.

Campfire Pit: An ideal place for those balmy nights, where groups can gather for an old fashioned 'sing-a-long', share some stories, toast marshmallows (bring these along with you) or just sit and enjoy the warmth and scenery.
